2017 Progress Report

Over the past four decades, JSI has helped more than 80 countries build and maintain strong health systems that are capable of delivering life-saving services and products to women, children, and adolescents, whenever and wherever they need them.

JSI first pledged to support progress toward the Millennium Development Goals through a 2011-2014 commitment to Every Woman Every Child (EWEC). To sustain and accelerate progress toward the Sustainable Development Goals, JSI joined many other nongovernmental organizations and private companies in pledging support for the EWEC campaign again in 2016. Working closely with our global and country-level partners, JSI exceeded its 2011–2014 commitments, and we are currently working to fulfil our six 2016-2020 commitments to improve maternal, child, and adolescent health. This report provides an update on our 2016-2020 EWEC goals.



GOAL 1

By 2020, scale up innovative reproductive, maternal, newborn, child, and adolescent health (RMNCH+A) approaches and interventions in **10 COUNTRIES**.

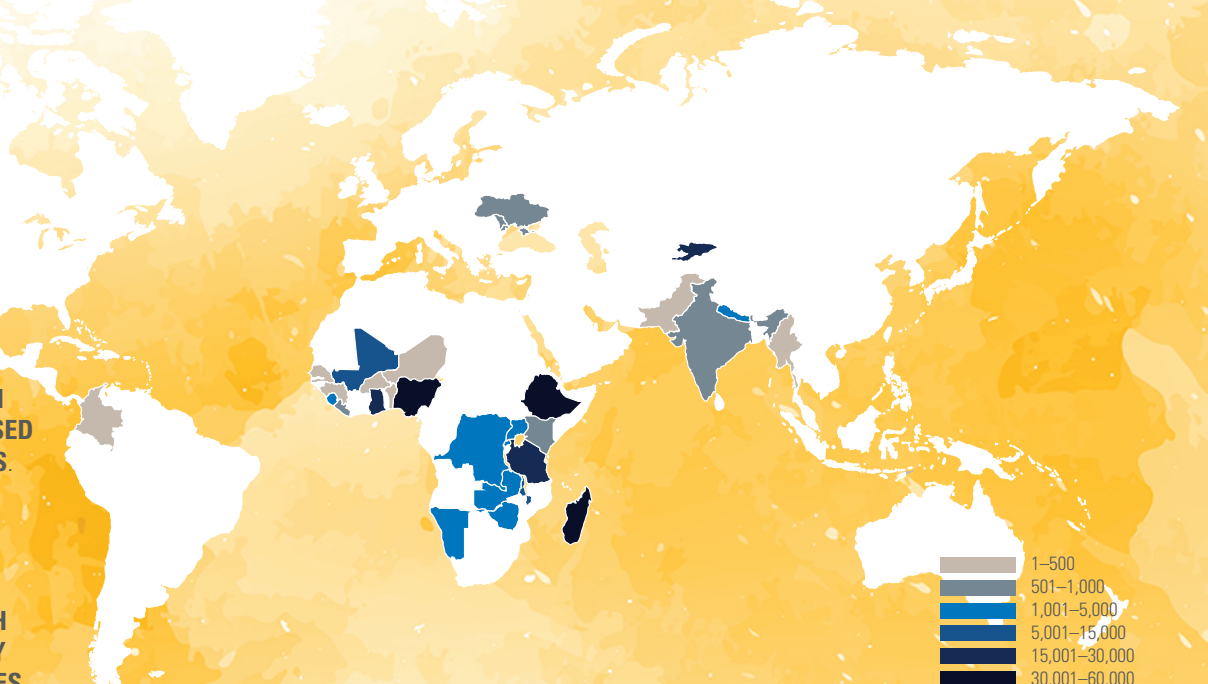
GOAL 4

By 2020, engage and empower communities in **10 COUNTRIES** through the training and support of **MORE THAN 20,000 HEALTH WORKERS, COMMUNITY-BASED WORKERS, AND VOLUNTEERS**.



PROGRESS

Since 2016, JSI has trained **247,488 INDIVIDUALS, HEALTH WORKERS, AND COMMUNITY VOLUNTEERS IN 31 COUNTRIES**.



GOAL 5

By 2020, tackle inequities in access to and use of immunization services in **10 COUNTRIES** by supporting approaches to Reach Every Community/Child and introducing new vaccines.

Since 2016, JSI has strengthened routine immunization systems in **22 COUNTRIES**:
