# 2020 Progress Report

Over the past four decades, JSI has helped more than 80 countries build and maintain strong health systems that are capable of delivering life-saving services and products to women, children, and adolescents, whenever and wherever they need them.

A decade ago, JSI pledged to support progress toward the Millennium Development Goals through a 2011–2014 commitment to Every Woman Every Child (EWEC). To sustain and accelerate progress toward the Sustainable Development Goals, JSI joined many other nongovernmental organizations and private companies in pledging support for the EWEC campaign again in 2016. Working closely with our global and country-level partners, JSI exceeded both our 2011–2014 commitments as well as our six 2016–2020 commitments. JSI is proud to have been a partner with the EWEC effort to advance the health and well-being of women, children and adolescents, everywhere.





By 2020, scale up innovative **reproductive**, **maternal**, **newborn**, **child**, **and adolescent health** (RMNCH+A) approaches and interventions in 10 countries.






By 2020, engage and empower communities in 10 countries through the training and support of more than 20,000 health workers, community-based workers, and volunteers.
