
Translating research and policy into reality

JSI's global HIV, TB and infectious disease programs play a critical role in translating policy pronouncements into operational reality.

Many countries have visionary policies but struggle to translate high level goals into site-level changes or client-level experience. The framework presented below outlines a change management process that can be applied to support the introduction of new interventions such as pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP)

as well as changes to existing interventions, such as multi-month dispensing (MMD) for antiretrovirals. Note the iterative loops in years three through five, which enable stakeholders to incorporate these changes into continuous quality improvement (CQI) practices, as well as to evaluate success.
