# INTERNATIONAL COVID-19 PROGRAMMING AT JSI

A global leader in comprehensive pandemic response



As a leading global provider of technical assistance and service delivery, JSI leverages existing health systems to address the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.

Ministries of health have engaged JSI to support the international COVID-19 pandemic response in over 28 countries. From preparedness planning to infection prevention and control, JSI staff have supported ministries of health worldwide to protect routine healthcare services while also monitoring and responding to COVID. JSI is also at the forefront of COVID-19 vaccine introduction and delivery, helping governments to develop systems, training COVID-19 providers in product management and delivery, coordinating information sharing with the public and private sectors, and engaging community leaders.

#### Vaccination

Since the emergence of COVID-19, JSI has leveraged its expertise in routine immunization and been at the forefront of COVID-19 vaccine introduction. At the global level, we are an advisor with the Country Readiness and Demand (CRD) working groups within the COVAX facility providing immunization expertise. At the country level, our technical assistance supports effective supply chain systems, vaccine introduction planning, provider training, targeted communications to build confidence and acceptance of the new vaccines, and safety and adverse events monitoring.



#### **Risk Communication and Community Engagement**

JSI works with host countries to reduce vaccine misinformation and create demand in eligible populations. We partner with national public health authorities and use evidence-based behavior change approaches to develop culturally-appropriate, gender-sensitive COVID-19 messages and disseminate them through mass media, social media and interpersonal communication channels.



## Infection Prevention and Control

JSI assesses health worker competency in infection prevention and control (IPC). Working with public health agencies and organizations to reinforce IPC practices and improve access to water, sanitation and hygiene supplies, we help mitigate the spread of infectious diseases.



### Case Management

We provide training and mentorship on updated COVID-19 clinical management guidelines to ensure that patients receive the best possible standard of care. JSI expands access to medical oxygen and procures other critical COVID-19 pharmaceuticals and treatment supplies.



#### Lab and Surveillance

We support national laboratory and surveillance capacity with high-quality health information systems for evidence-based decision-making. In addition to digital solutions to strengthen surveillance systems, JSI supports efforts to reduce turnaround time and protect ongoing diagnostic needs.
