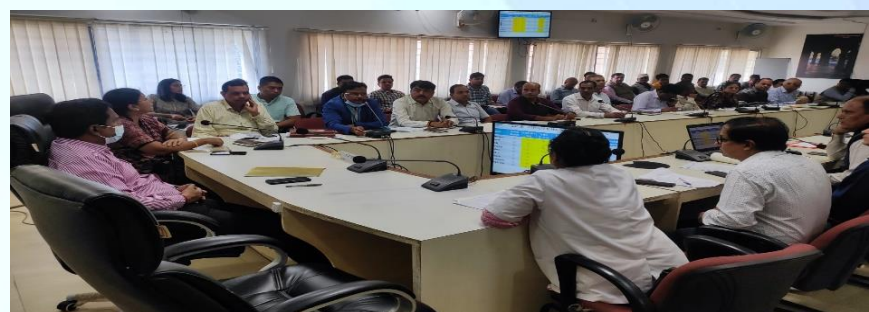

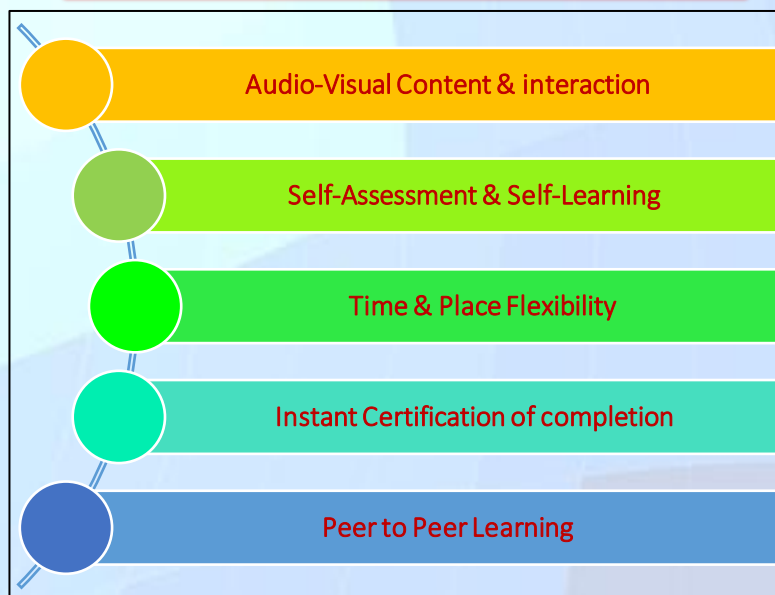

### What is RISE?

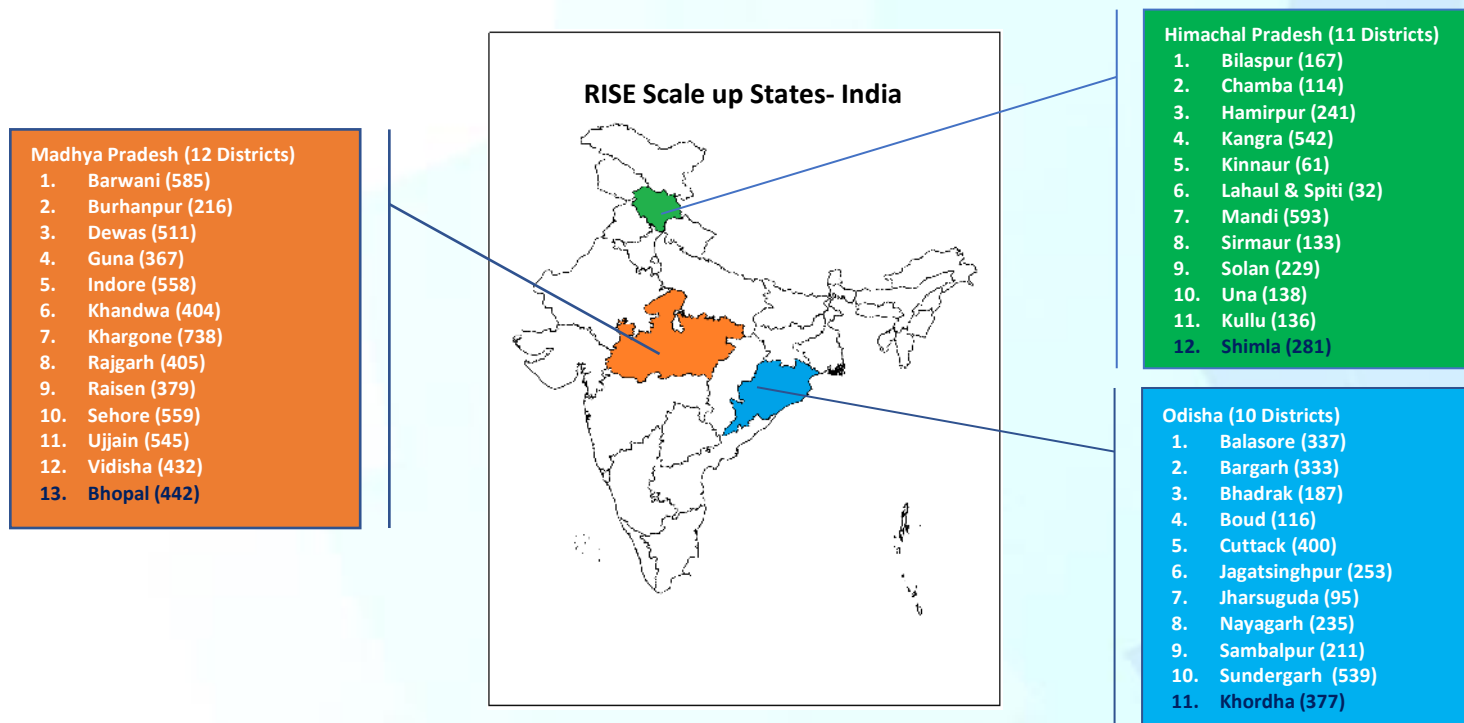

- Sustainable program to cater varied cadres

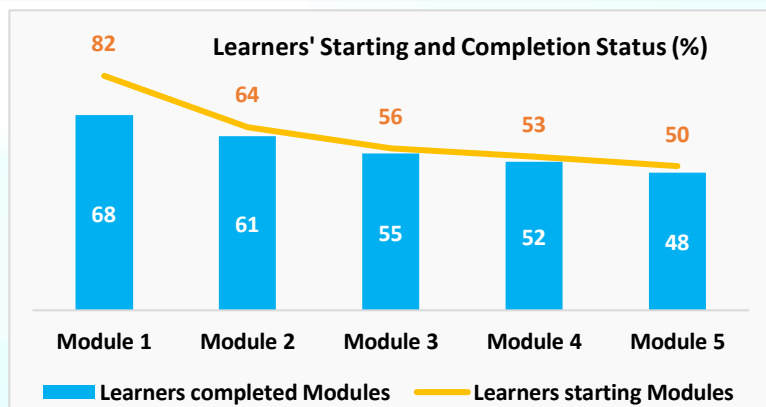

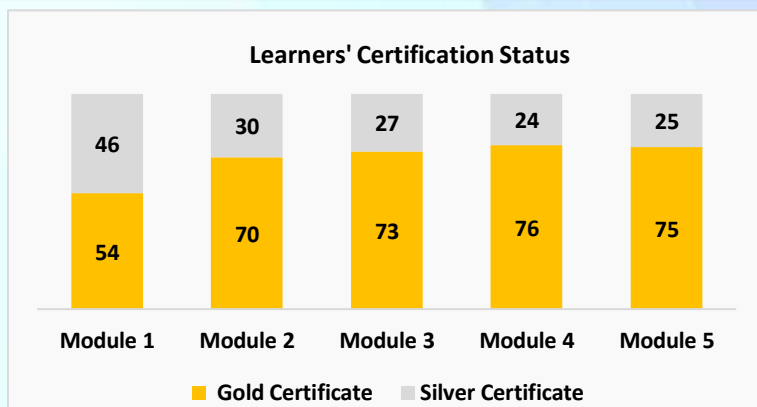
## RISE Scale up, 2021-2022



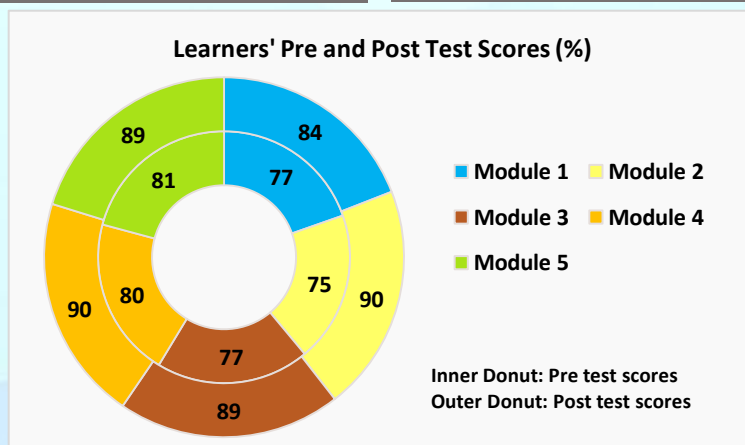
## Concurrent Monitoring of RISE Scale up, 2021-2022



About 13,000+ learners in 36 districts have been accessing and completing the course



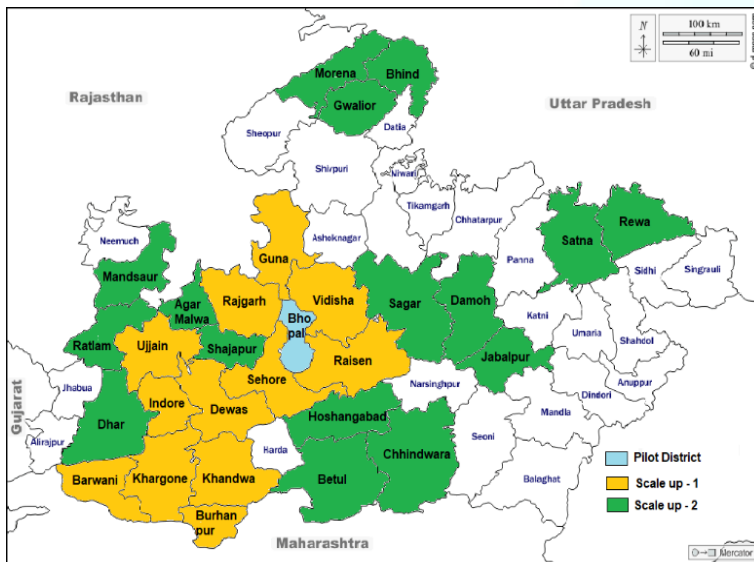
Highest percentage of Gold certificate is in Module 4, followed by Module 5



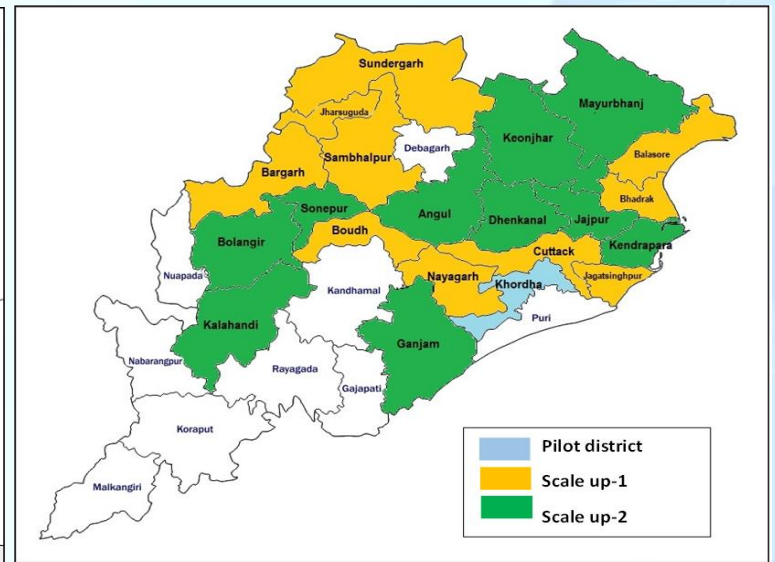
- On an average 10 points increase in knowledge levels is observed among the learners

## Activities in the Field for RISE Scale up, 2022-23

Eight out of 16 districts in Madhya Pradesh have completed the district ToT and block level training successfully. Likewise, eight out of 10 districts from Odisha have successfully carried out district ToT and block level training are in progress. More than 4500 health workers have been oriented with the RISE and are accessing the course.

## Feedback from the Field, RISE Scale up, 2022-23

I am working as ADPHO (FW), Ganjam, Odisha since last 5 years. We were conducting residential training programs for vaccinators every year but **when I learned about the RISE training program, I was very impressed**. RISE app takes the learners through step-by-step video sessions and question answer session. It gives conceptual clarity with the ease and fun of learning.

RISE module 1 started on 14<sup>th</sup> November, 2022 in our district. In the initial period, there were some problems at the field level especially for the senior vaccinators but gradually all got acquainted with the functionality of the app. Now they are showing their interest to complete the modules. Module 1 took 7 days for 90% completion, but during Module 3, 50% vaccinators completed it only within 2 days. Percentage of earning gold certificates also increased from 58% in Module 1 to 80% now in module 3. It shows vaccinators' interest and involvement with the training app.

**As the nodal officer of the district for the program, I make sure that regular follow up to the block nodal persons about completion of the module in time is done and daily module wise completion status shared in the RISE WhatsApp group to speed up the process.** Field level orientations of vaccinators were completed as a mission after the district ToT and one district resource person deployed to each block and urban units to give hand holding support during training at field level. If some vaccinators are not able to complete the module due to lack of mobile operating knowledge, they are called to the block CHCs and BDMs give them hand holding support. If any problem arises then we tried to solve the issue with the help of RISE state officials.

RISE is highly beneficial to the vaccinators and helpful during their regular immunization sessions. **The positive aspect is that they can choose and learn in their own language. This is a best platform to enhance the skill of a vaccinator.**
