Journey of RISE Project, 2021-2024

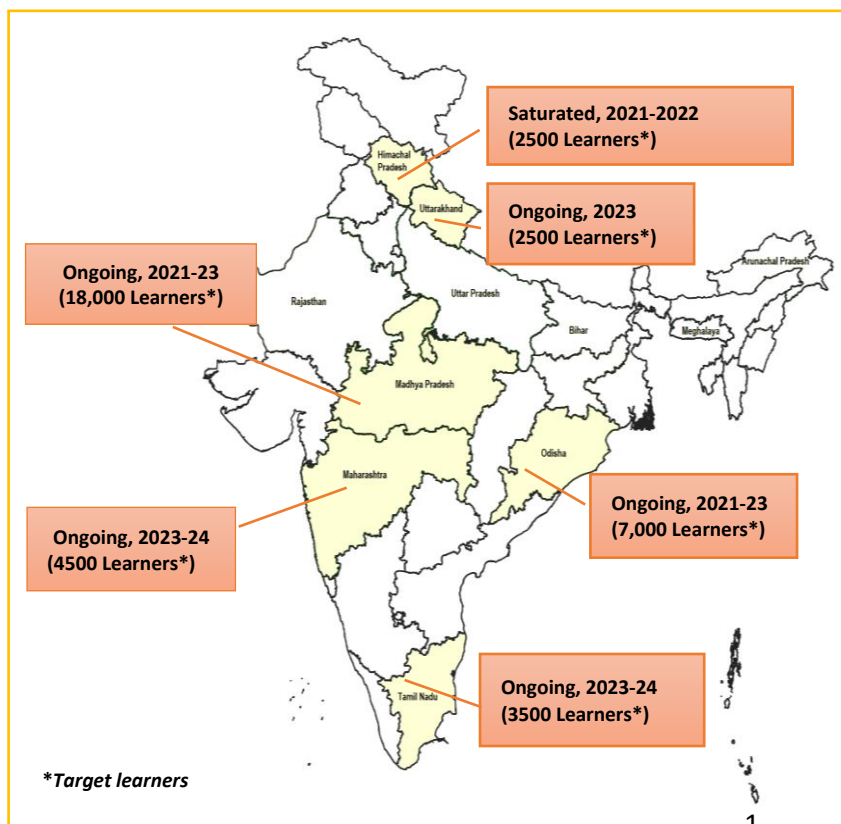
RISE (Rapid Immunization Skill Enhancement) was piloted in the year 2020 with more than 2600 learners in five districts – Shimla (Himachal Pradesh), Bhopal (Madhya Pradesh), Khordha (Odisha), Pune (Maharashtra) and Kancheepuram (Tamil Nadu).

During 2021-2022, the project expanded to 33 districts in Himachal Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and Odisha reaching to more than 12,500 learners.

In 2023, after saturating Himachal Pradesh, the project stepped in 13 districts of Uttarakhand. Along with, it gradually expanded to 16 more districts in Madhya Pradesh and 10 more districts in Odisha and further reaching to more than 24,000 health workers.

Currently (2023-24), the project is mandated to be implemented in the remaining 22 districts of Madhya Pradesh and 9 districts of Odisha. After completion, both the states will be saturated with the RISE training whilst, RISE has started in Maharashtra (15 Districts and corporations) and Tamil Nadu (15 districts) in a phased manner.

The project aims to reach more than 40,000 learners by the end of the year 2023. In addition, 5 more states and 80,000 more learners will be enrolled by 2026.

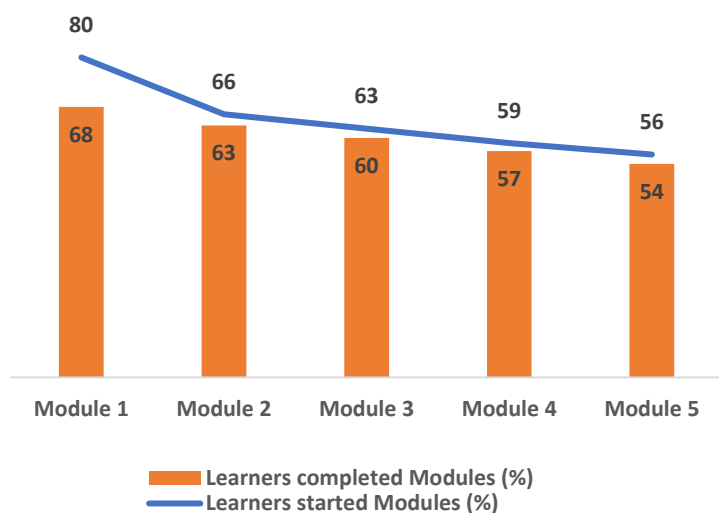

Concurrent Monitoring of the districts where RISE modules are Live

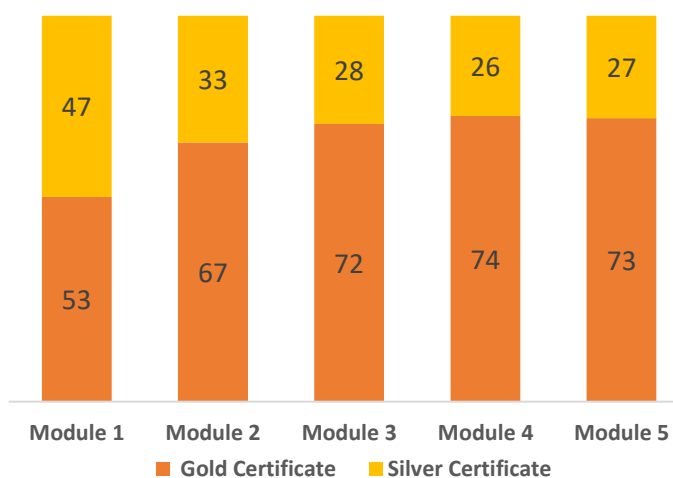
Learners start and completion status (%)

N=32,064*



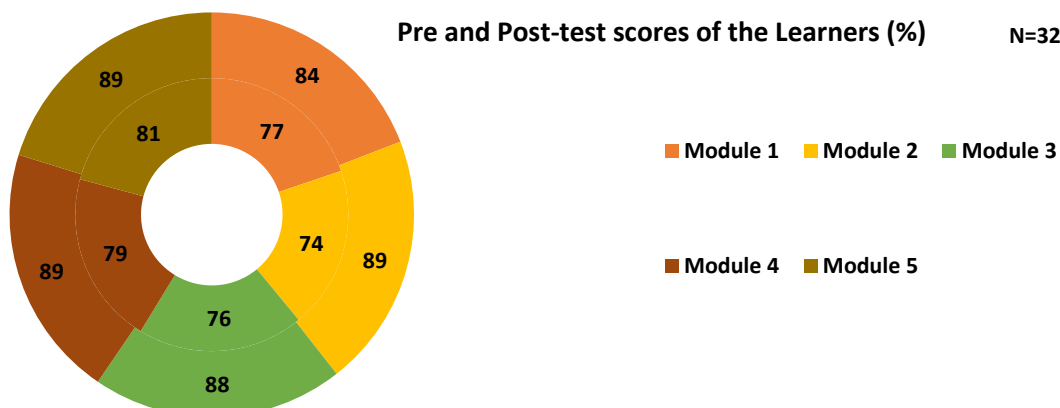
Certification status (%)
